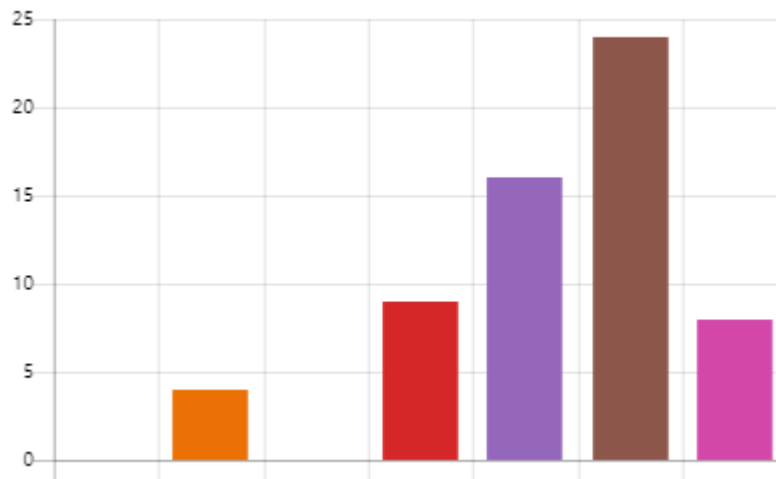

Question 8

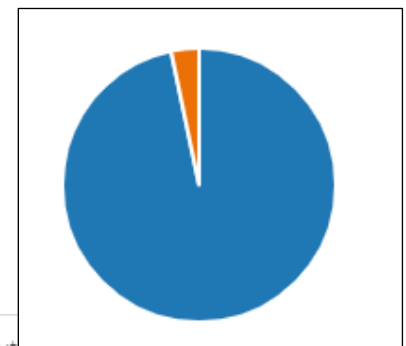
Is there enough work being set at the moment? (52 responses)

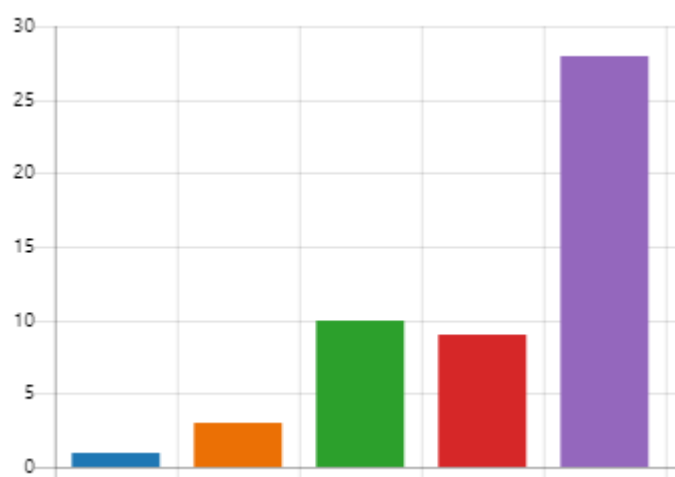
Are your children receiving feedback in the work they are submitting on Class Dojo/portfolios?

Home learning that doesn't need printing out | We are encouraging online learning wherever possible so that children can interact with lessons prepared and delivered by their teachers and teachers can assess the work produced and feedback. We have asked teachers wherever possible to adapt learning so that tasks can be completed with pencil and paper or resources commonly found at home to reduce the need for printing worksheets |
| Children are losing interest / struggling to engage in home learning | We are trying to make our online provision as engaging as possible and are setting the amount of home learning in line with government guidance. We have tips to support children with home learning for parents and children on our website and we will email these out to you. We will look at additional ways of rewarding engagement such as receiving a letter from Mrs Summers. Many of us are parents ourselves and we understand the difficulty of juggling work and home learning. We appreciate how hard you are working with your children as they complete their home learning and would ask that you do the best you can in challenging circumstances. |

| Why are we not doing live online lessons | We feel that recording our lessons means that lessons are available to suit everyone's needs at a time that suits them especially when siblings may be sharing devices. As well as preparing and delivering online lessons teachers are also in school teaching which means that they are not always available for live online teaching.
