English

Children in both year 4 and 5 will be focusing on nonchronological reports. The end goal is to write a nonchronological report on what we know about mountain which is our topic for Autumn 1. The first week back we will be concentrating on our punctuation ladders which will help provide a platform for not only our reports but for the rest on the year. For our class hook day we will pretend to be mountaineers and will hike around the school and aim to cover the distance of Everest. After this we will then create our own mountains sculptures. Throughout the term we will look at the key features within a non-chronological report, as well as a PIP and a POP.

Maths

During this term we will be concentrating on the different operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) within maths. During the first couple of week will work on addition and subtractions as this will again help provide a solid platform for the rest of the year and is a vital skill to master. After this the pupil's will be working on their place value which will help recognise numbers up to 10,000. Finally the class will be focusing on their timetables and division with daily practice on TTrockstars and LBQ as we need to have a big push

This term our projects are ...

Our LKS2 Topic during Autumn term 1 is 'Mountains'

We will be looking at mountains around the world this term and how they are made. Our book for the term is 'Mountains Geographics' which explains why and how mountains are made including interesting facts and information about mountains around the world.

This will be cross curricular as we will cover mountains through out English with our non-chronological reports and art with our mountain sculptures.

Science this term is focusing on Animals and their movement and nutrition. This will then include lesson on the skeletons, the bones within our body and the muscles and movement. Following this we will then cover lessons on eating for survival, nutrient groups and a balanced diet.

Our LKS2 Topic during Autumn term 2 is 'Fantastic Mr. Fox'

We will be looking at the story of Fantastic Mr. Fox which will assist with our fiction writing focus in English. We will look at the story in depth, focusing on characters, settings and events. We will also use drama and theatre to enhance the children knowledge of the text.

Our science focus during this term will be forces and spaces which will involve lots of practical activities and investigations. Once again assessments will be caried out at the beginning and end of term.

Learning at home



The agreed expectation is that all children in key stage two at Grange Primary School read at least **4 times a week** at home. This can be to an adult, or a sibling. Any reading must be recorded in the yellow or green reading records sent home with the book. It doesn't have to be much, just a smile or a small acknowledgement with a signature.

Children will also be brining home weekly homework which will be focusing on the following week's spelling patterns. Also, the children will be brining home times tables to complete.

All homework will be set and sent home on **Fridays** stuck in homework books and must be returned to school every **Wednesday**.


Forest
